Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Precision Connector, Inc. is aware of and concerned by reports that profits from the sale of certain metals mined in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries have helped fuel war and human rights violations in the eastern Congo. We support ending the violence and human rights violations in the mining of certain minerals from a location described as the "Conflict Region".

As a result, The US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) adopted final rule to implement reporting and disclosure requirements related to "Conflict Minerals", as directed by the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010. The rules require manufacturers who file certain reports with the SEC, sec 12(a) or 15(d) of the Exchange Act, to disclose whether the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture contain "conflict minerals" that are "necessary to the functionality or production" of these products.

While we, as a privately held company, are not subject to the Conflict Minerals rule and reporting requirements, we understand that our customers may be and we are committed to helping our customers comply with their reporting requirements.

Precision Connector, Inc., a designer and manufacturer of precision rf and microwave frequency coaxial connectors has no control or degree of influence in the mining, smelting, processing or procurement of Conflict Minerals in the products we use. Precision Connector, Inc. is committed to ensuring that Conflict Minerals do not knowingly enter our supply chain. Any components and/or special processes we procure or subcontract will be from suppliers who have in good faith published a policy concerning Conflict Minerals.

We will continue to work with our suppliers to ensure that we are able to identify the use of Conflict Minerals in our supply chain, and that the representations made in this compliance statement remain accurate. To that end, we reserve the right to amend this statement at any time based on subsequent developments or information.
